VOTING INFORMATION	
ELECTIONS	
On election day, the polls are open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Early voting will be available at designated locations in each county prior to Election Day. Voters must present valid identification (photo ID, signature); otherwise, they must vote a Provisional ballot.	
To participate in the primary election of a particular party, voters must be registered in that party. However, if all candidates for an office are from the same party and will not face opposition in the general election, then all qualified voters may cast a ballot in the primary, regardless of party affiliation.	
In the general election, you may vote for the candidate of your choice without regard to political party.

VOTER REGISTRATION	
You must register in the county of residence in Florida and must be:	
* a United States citizen	
* at least 18 years of age	
* in possession of your voting rights

* registered 29 days prior to the election	
Registration applications are available at drivers' license offices, public libraries or at the offices of the Supervisors of Elections. Check SOE websites for details.
