Rick is a lifelong resident of Pensacola who developed an interest in marine science while snorkeling as a kid. He received his B.S. from Troy University, where he did his marine science work at Dauphin Island Sea Lab, and his M.S. from the University of Southern Mississippi. His focus of study were marine vertebrates, particularly fish and reptiles.

He has been a marine science instructor for 38 years teaching at Dauphin Island Sea Lab, Pensacola State College66 and developed the Marine Science Academy at Washington High School for the Escambia County School District . He currently serves as the Florida Sea Grant county extension agent where he works with local stakeholders with an interest in our estuarine/marine environment focusing on programs in healthy ecosystems, workforce development, and enhancing science literacy.
